Malav Dani is the personification of compassionate capitalism. Malav serves as a non-executive director on the board of Asian Paints Limited and Chairman of its CSR committee. He has helmed Hitech Corporation Limited as Managing Director since 2011, during which time his unassuming yet highly inspirational leadership style has pioneered its growth, expansion, and shaping of the company's trajectory. He is also currently the president of Hitech Global Inc. in the USA, which was incorporated in 2024 and is a subsidiary of Hitech Corporation Limited.

Malav's strong belief in "Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam," which means that the world is one family, finds him bringing together people from diverse cultures and backgrounds to create synergies and tackle global challenges. This is reflected in his serving as Chairman of the Indian American International Chamber of Commerce (IAICC) International Board. His vision is to promote economic development, fostering bilateral trade and investment globally by bringing together empathic humans at a micro level, causing the strengthening of bilateral relations between the two countries and with the rest of the world at a macro level.

With a deep desire to contribute to society, he has set up the Sab ka Mangal Ho Foundation, which means the well-being of all. The foundation looks at implementing holistic solutions at grassroots levels to generate social transformation. Some of the initiatives undertaken include environmental conservation, food for orphans and teaching Yoga in orphanages.

Malav has often expressed that the spread of the ageless practices of Yoga when imbibed by the masses, will cause an elevation of human consciousness that is strong enough to meet all global challenges with global peace, harmony, and abundance as an outcome. Driven by this vision, he has started working on an online global platform called Yoga.in.

He was also appointed as the Chairman of the Ease of Doing Business Committee of the Indian Merchants Chamber from 2015 –2018, where he had an opportunity to present the Roadmap for India to improve its Ease of Doing Business ranking to the Joint Parliamentary Standing Committee on Commerce of the Rajya Sabha.
