PROMOTING A SECURE FUTURE FOR AMERICA AND ITS INTERNATIONAL ALLIES

Dr. Krishna Reddy, a doctor, prominent philanthropist, political trailblazer and intrepid leader in the Indo-American community, is the epitome of the American Dream.

Born and professionally educated in Bangalore, India, Dr. Reddy came to the U.S. for the opportunity to serve the country and community. He has fulfilled various leadership roles in numerous civic organizations, including as Chairman of the federation of Indo-Americans, Board of Directors in Red Cross, president of the Gandhi Peace Foundation in California and Lions Club. Presently, Dr. Reddy is serving as the Founder/Chairman of the Indian American Friendship Council.

Dr. Reddy's vision for strengthening U.S. and India relations is matched by his devotion and tenacity in bringing that vision to life. His work in the past few decades highlights the importance of cooperation between two allies and their shared ideologies, particularly on matters of national security and the international war on radical terrorism.

A close friend and political ally to Dr. Reddy, Robert D. Blackwill, who is also the former U.S. Ambassador to India and Senior Fellow at the Council of Foreign Relations stated, *"The values of democracy and free markets are mutually reinforcing. Both are based on the freedom of choice, the rule of law and transparency."*

The Indian American Friendship Council (IAFC), founded by Dr. Reddy in 1990, is one such example of his involvement in key areas of national security, trade and social progress.

From defense policies and cyber terrorism to technology and bilateral trade, Dr. Reddy has helped create opportunities of mutual benefit to the U.S. and India. His uncompromising efforts have earned praise from President Bush and President Clinton for expanding bilateral relations between the two countries, and he has a strong appreciation of Prime Minister Modi and the President of India.

As the current President and Founder of the Indian American Friendship Council, as well as the author of several articles and books on socio-political issues, Dr. Reddy has proven to be a formidable influence in Washington and abroad. His multi-faceted approach to challenges that affect both countries has garnered the respect of countless political leaders across party lines.

Since its inception, the IAFC has served as a forum for promoting a stronger bond between the two largest democracies in the world, India and the United States, with its Annual Legislative Conference. Its mission is to improve relations between the U.S. and India, support developing countries, promote global democracy, protect the interests of the Indian-American community, and educate Members of Congress on various issues also lauded by the U.S. Congress as well as Indian

Building on values of freedom, peace, stability, and cooperation shared by both countries, Dr. Reddy has worked closely with members of Congress and as a distinguished leader in the Indian Hindu community to initiate actionable referendums. The work of Dr. Reddy and the organization has been formally recognized through Congressional Resolutions.

Dr. Reddy has devoted his life to focusing on vital issues of national and international security. He authored the book *“Global Terrorists and Nuclear Threats to U.S. and Indian Democracies”* which reinforces the need for cooperation. Dr. Reddy was also instrumental in India's nuclear deal, given his understanding of the link between national security and regional stability.

The compendium of knowledge presented by Dr. Reddy, in his writing and through official appearances on stage, offers clear insight into what many leaders in the intelligence community also share – that the United States and India are natural allies.

To this effect, the core message of the annual IAFC conferences has remained the same since 1997 until today: The United States and India need to continue building strong alliances of friendship and political cooperation to defeat terrorism, oppressive dictatorships and religious persecution throughout the world.

Dr. Reddy has also tackled the growing concern of HIV/Aids in India. Through his book, *“India's Deadly Enemy – HIV/AIDS,”* as well as grassroots campaigns in social and political arenas, he has helped educate and identify possible solutions to eradicate the spread of HIV/AIDs from the community. Dr. Reddy's efforts in

improving the lives of millions have earned recognition and respect from the highest levels of leadership.

Congressman Ed Royce chairman of the Congressional Foreign Relations Committee said, *“Dr. Reddy’s contributions to U.S.-India is the guiding light for all our deliberations.”*
